Ride the Green Bus! ChescoBus is the largest public transportation service in Chester County. With two routes, it delivers scheduled, fixed-route transportation connecting residents and employees to popular areas such as Coatesville, Parkesburg, West Chester and Kennett Square.

ChescoBus is a fully insured, fixedroute public transportation service. All ChescoBuses are equipped with wheelchair lifts and bicycle racks for up to 2 bicycles.

Seniors over the age of 65 and children 4 years or under (with a parent) ride free at all times on any ChescoBus. Riders with a valid Medicare Card or PA Disability Transit ID Card also ride at a discounted rate.
